Dear Parents and Carers,

As our trip to the Isle of Wight fast approaches I just wanted to advise you the key times and arrangements, plus packing list.

Monday 5th June 2023

Please drop your child to school at 8:30am the coach will be leaving at 9am promptly.

Friday 9th June 2023

It is estimated the coach will be back between 2.30pm-3pm. We will update parents of their arrival via MyChildAtSchool app on the afternoon, with an exact time of arrival to school.

Hotel & Contact information

We are staying at Langham Court Hotel in Shankin.

Please email Mrs Butler (sealheadofschool@inspirefederation.co.uk) if for any reason your child's circumstances change during the half term holiday resulting in them not being able to go on the trip.

Swimming

We need to know your child's swimming ability. We require parents to complete the form via this link: <https://forms.office.com/e/qXzKFVc8zr> This must be completed by Wednesday 24th May 2023. Please inform us if your child is a non-swimmer, swims a little – but not confident or is a capable swimmer and can confidently swim 25 metres. It is important that the form is completed by Wednesday 24th May.

Allergies and Emergency contact numbers

If you have not already informed us of any allergies/medical requirements we need to be aware of, please email office@inspirefederation.co.uk, by Wednesday 24th May 2023. Please also advise us if there may be different emergency contact telephone numbers we may need to use to contact you (that are different from the numbers we have on our system).

Medicine

Please collect and complete a medicine form from the school office **prior** to the trip. Please hand in medicines & inhalers, along with the completed form to Mrs Butler on Monday morning. All medicines need to be clearly labelled with your child's name and dosage.

Packed Lunch/School dinner

The children will require a packed lunch on Monday 5th June. Please include this in your child's day bag and ensure the packed lunch is in disposable packaging. Please ensure your child brings a refillable water bottle for the trip, included in their day bag.

Spending money

We recommend each child to have £6 per day to spend from Monday to Thursday (no money required for Friday). Please can we ask for the Monday to be in separate envelopes per day, as these will be kept safe with a member of staff and issued out daily to the children.

Sweets

Children will have an opportunity to spend some of their money at the Tuck Shop, which will be available in the evenings at the hotel. We therefore ask that no sweets are packed in the children's bags.

Phones & Electronic Devices

May I remind you that phones and electric devices are not allowed on the trip. We shall send you updates throughout our stay and post photographs via Facebook. Please let us know if you need to change your child's permission to allow photos to be unloaded on Facebook.

Kit List

Please pack all kit in a medium holdall/rucksack or cabin size suitcase. Please label all items of clothing. It would help the children if they were given a list so that they can repack all their things. I have included one for you to use should you wish.

ITEMS TO PACK

- Casual clothes (trousers/t-shirts/jumpers/skirts/tops/t-shirts)
- Waterproof jacket/coat
- Wellie Boots/carrier bag
- Sun cream & hat
- Indoor shoes/slippers
- Trainers/plimsolls
- Nightclothes
- Toiletry bag containing: toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, hairbrush etc
- Towel for showers/baths/washing
- Socks and underwear
- Disco outfit
- Swimming costume and towel
- Large plastic bag for dirty/wet clothes
- Any medication required as per form completed
- Rucksack and water bottle for going on trips – day bag
- Night-time teddy bear!

Please LABEL all items of clothing. Children should be given a list of their packed items so they can ensure they repack everything.

Please do not bring expensive items such as mobile telephones, electronic games or personal stereo players, cherished jewellery, expensive clothing as we cannot take responsibility should they get damaged or lost.
