Update from Mrs Jones, Head of School

We have had a great start to the year with attendance and punctuality. We are currently on 97% attendance and aiming for 98%. This is higher than last year's attendance and I am very grateful for the parental support. With such high attendance, there is no limit to what the children can achieve!

Likewise, with punctuality - thank you to all parents who have ensured their children are in school before 8:50am. This has had a huge impact on lessons being able to start promptly. I am very grateful have such supportive families here at Seal

The procedure for forest school kits is as follows:

The first time your child forgets their kit, we will offer them a spare kit if we are able to. You will then be issued with a uniform slip reminding you to bring it in.

If this happens on subsequent occasions, unfortunately your child will not be able to participate in forest school and will be asked to complete work in another classroom. We cannot have children in the forest without appropriate kit.
