Communicating collection arrangements

We are currently experiencing daily high volumes of calls from parents to communicate changes in end of day collection arrangements. Please can I ask, if you are aware that someone else will be collecting your child prior to the day, that you email your child's class teacher no later than **5pm the day before.** Of course, there will be occasions where there are last minute changes. In these instances, please ensure that you do phone the school office as <u>class teachers will not pick up emails whilst they are teaching</u>. We are hopeful that this will reduce the number of phone calls to the school office each given day, as this is currently posing a significant challenge to ensuring that each class teacher is informed of daily collection arrangements. Please note this applies to normal end of day collection arrangements and not appointments during the school day which should continue to be sent to the office team office@inspiream.org.uk


