Updates from Mrs Jones

Attendance

School attendance has dropped to 95% and we are striving for at least 98% to ensure pupils do not miss out on essential learning in order for them to make the progress that they deserve.


As a result, I want to draw your attention to the following:

- If your child has head lice, we will not authorise a day's absence. Head lice must be treated but this should be done at home after or before school.
- We will no longer be authorising absence for sickness or diarrhoea which lasts longer than 48 hours, unless there is medical evidence, for example a Surgery/GP appointment card, email or text.
- If your child is unwell, we require specific reasons for their absence and "feeling poorly" is not a sufficient reason. Without specific details of their illness, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised.
- If a child is absent and there is no reason for absence communicated, it will be marked as unauthorised.

If children accrue 10 or more half day sessions of unauthorised absence, this could lead to a penalty notice for parental condoned absence or a statutory referral to Kent County Council which may lead to prosecution. It is a parent's legal responsibility to ensure that pupils are in school when they are fit and well. It is also the parent's responsibility to ensure pupils are in school on time. If we begin to have concerns for a child's punctuality, children's late marks may begin to be marked as unauthorised lateness which again, could lead to prosecution.

Together, we have a responsibility to ensure that all pupils have access to a high quality education and pupils' attendance and punctuality is crucial.


