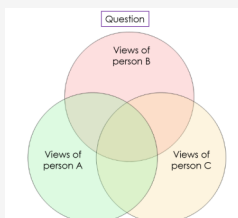

| <b>Father</b>      | In the Trinity, "Father" represents the part of God that is often seen as the creator and leader, like the head of a family.   |
| <b>Son</b>         | In the Trinity, "Son" refers to the part of God that is connected to Jesus, who came to Earth to teach and help people.  |
| <b>Holy Spirit</b> | The Holy Spirit is like a special presence in the Trinity that helps people feel close to God and guides them in their faith.  |
| <b>Trinity</b>     | The belief that there is one God who exists in three different forms or persons - the Father, the Son (Jesus), and the Holy Spirit. It's a bit like one person with three roles.                 |
| <b>belief</b>      | Belief is when you have strong faith in something, even if you can't see it. It's like trusting in something important, like kindness and love.  |
| <b>Pentecost</b>   | Pentecost is a special day for some Christians when they celebrate the Holy Spirit coming to help Jesus' followers. They tell stories and have special prayers to remember this important event. |

## Knowledge

### I will need to know:

- Christians believe God is Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- Christians believe The Father creates; he sends the Son who saves his people; the Son sends the Holy Spirit to his followers.
- Jesus, the Son of God, is seen by Christians as revealing what God the Father is like
- Understanding God is challenging; people spend their whole lives learning more and more about God
- Christians believe the Holy Spirit is God's power at work in the world and in their lives today, enabling them to follow Jesus.
