Dear Parent/Carer,

We are very excited for our upcoming Sports Days and would love to share some further details with you.

Following the same format as last year, sports day will run over two days, with **KS1 taking part on Thursday 23rd May** and **KS2 taking part on Friday 24th May**. We wanted to offer the children some extra 'round-robin' activities to increase inclusivity- something for everyone to enjoy! These will take place during the morning with flat races commencing in the afternoon.

Please see below for a full itinerary of each day.

KS1 Sports Day – Thursday 23rd May 2024

10am- 12pm- Children take part in 'round robin' events as classes, accompanied by their class teachers. Parents are invited to spectate.

12pm-12.30pm- a picnic on the school field with your child, if you are able to attend. You are welcome to bring a picnic to share with your child. Alternatively, children may collect a 'take away' version of the day's school dinner. If you would prefer your child to have the takeaway version of school dinners, please book as normal on the Ch&Co website. If, for any reason you are unable to attend, pupils will have a picnic lunch with their class teacher. Please provide a packed lunch, or book school dinners, as usual.

12.30pm-3:00pm- Flat races

There will also be the chance for mums, dads, siblings and teachers to compete in their own races! This will be followed by the winners' announcement and prize giving.

Afterwards, children can be collected by parents at the finishing time along with any older siblings; a teacher will be sent to collect older siblings from their classes to meet parents.

KS2 Sports Day – Friday 24th May 2024

10am- 12pm- Children take part in 'round robin' events as classes, accompanied by their class teachers. Parents are invited to spectate.

12pm-12.30pm - a picnic on the school field with your child, if you are able to attend. You are welcome to bring a picnic to share with your child. Alternatively, children may collect a 'take away' version of the day's school dinner. If you would prefer your child to have the takeaway version of school dinners, please book as normal on the Ch&Co website. If, for any reason you are unable to attend, pupils will have a picnic lunch with their class teacher. Please provide a packed lunch, or book school dinners, as usual.

12.30pm-3pm- Flat races

Again, there will also be the chance for mums, dads, siblings and teachers to compete in their own races! This will be followed by the winners' announcement and prize giving.

Afterwards, Teachers will take pupils back to their classrooms and parents to collect Y3 from classroom doors. Years 4-6 will line up on playground as usual for parents to collect. Parents may go to younger siblings' classrooms to collect early if necessary.

Other information:

- Children must bring a **water bottle** to school on their Sports Day.
- Children will wear their **house-coloured t-shirt**. (Please ask your child's class teacher if you need to know your child's house) and the rest of their PE kit (shorts/ tracksuit bottoms and trainers).
- Any siblings, not on roll at Seal Primary School, joining you on the day remain your responsibility as parents.
- If there is **extreme wet weather, we will postpone** both Sports Days to a date in term 6 and will inform parents via text message of the cancellation the day before.
- Please **walk to school** if possible as parking will be difficult on this day. Please be considerate of our residents when parking.
