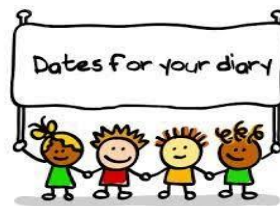
*PTA connects you to other parents and teachers through meetings, events and communications, helping to build a sense of community*
