

R.E. lesson 1 KS1 – CREATION



Learning question – who made the world?

Christians believe God created the world and the story is told in the Bible in Genesis 1-2 – I have attached a copy from The Lion Children's Bible so a grown up can read the story to you if you wish. Here is a short summary of the story -

In the beginning...the earth was dark, deep and wild.

On Day 1, God created LIGHT as well as DAY and NIGHT.

On Day 2, He made the SKY – a blue horizon wide and high.

On Day 3, He separated the SEA and made the LAND. On the land, He created SEEDS, PLANTS, GRASSES and TREES.

On Day 4, He gave the world, SUNSHINE, MOONLIGHT and STARS.

On Day 5, He filled the sky and sea with BIRDS and FISH of every variety.

On Day 6, He filled the land with ANIMALS from the tiny ant to the grizzly bear as well as the first HUMANS.

On Day 7, He rested.

1. Create a storyboard of the Creation story – draw and write what happened on each day. You could set it out like this...

3. Create a fact file of your favourite animal – research its habitat, food, body size and special features/facts.
