
Hal is on a space adventure, can you help him?

Back to Earth with a Bump - Reasoning




5. Hal is almost home after finding the Sun. He says he will be back in half an hour. Mission Control say it will take 30 mins. Who is right?

The shapes are in the row and from the left.


The rulers are in the row and from the right.

The maths books are in the row and from the right.


Describe the position of other items.


Next, can you describe halves and quarters to another person? Remember to use the word equal!

One quarter is 1 of 4 equal parts. So, this circle is cut into 4 equal parts. The green shaded part is one quarter.



We can use this language when making instructions. For example, when we are talking about turning.





A whole turn, would be turning all the way round, facing back where you started. See if you can have a go turning an object or yourself! Have a look at this power point to help you!


## Spring
