ice pictures

 Smash some frozen puddles and use the bits of ice to make a mosaic-like picture on the ground.

• Alternatively, make pictures from pre-prepared ice blocks made in a selection of containers, e.g. plastic boxes, ice-cream tubs and metal baking trays. Fill with water and a few drops of food colouring (perhaps pink for a fairy or blue for a monster!). Leave the filled containers outside overnight to freeze, and then remove them and see what pictures you can make.





Collect some ice- Experiment how to melt the ice.

What can you use to melt the ice? Salt? Sugar? Nothing? time? Cold water? Hot water? Steam? Baking powder?



ice castles

Can you make glistening fortress for an ice queen?

Natural ice can de Collect ice from broken puddles or the edge of a small earn. Choose a special place to build your castle perhaps on a log, a tree stump or a rock, or in a corner of the garden. Fit the ice pieces together to make a castle. Spraying cold water on to the ice should help stick the pieces together. Add sticks and stones to make it stronger if you wish, and perhaps leaves covered in hoar frost to decorate.

Moulded ice castle Make some assorted ice blocks (see page 120) and use them to build a castle, a palace or even an ice monster's lair. Square blocks are good for walls and round blocks make great turrets. (For more ice castles, see page 112)



ice windows

Hunt for ready-made ice windows on frozen puddles, or design your own windows and leave them outside to freeze.

Take some flat-bottomed dishes or metal trays outside and pour water into them to a depth of about 2.5cm/1in. Place a plastic beaker filled with pebbles in each container, this will make a

Natural ice window. Arrange natural materials such as coloured leaves, seeds a service flowers in the water.

Stained-c' effect ice window. Add a few drops of food colouring to the water in the container. Once the water has of warm water for a few seconds. Carefully tip out each ice up your windows outdoors and enjoy them until they melt.

Ice bunting. Fill lots of small containers with different-coloured water and put a loop of string in each one. Once frezen, he the coloured ice bunting.

ice lanterns

Imagine a magical trail of ice lanterns leading through the garden or the park on a frosty night. The more lanterns you make, the more dramatic the effect will be.

 Fill plastic tubs and buckets with water and leave them outside on a freezing cold night. The water should freeze around the sides and bottom of each tub, making a cup-like shape.

 In extremely cold weather the water might freeze solid so place a smaller container full of pebbles inside a larger orate the lantern (see page 113), put container of water lown between the two containers.

• The next decremove the ice from the containers, using a little warm water to loosen it if you need to. Place one or more

For a larger ice lantern on a stand, place three sticks, each one about 1m/3ft in length, in a bucket of water. Once it has frozen, turn it out and you will have a large ice lantern on its own tripod.







