
Activity:

Which animal is the cheapest? How do you know?

Example:

The penguin is the cheapest pet to buy because I know 2 is smaller than 10. I would need two pennies or a 2p coin to buy the penguin but I would need ten pennies or 10p coin to buy the lion So I would need more money.
