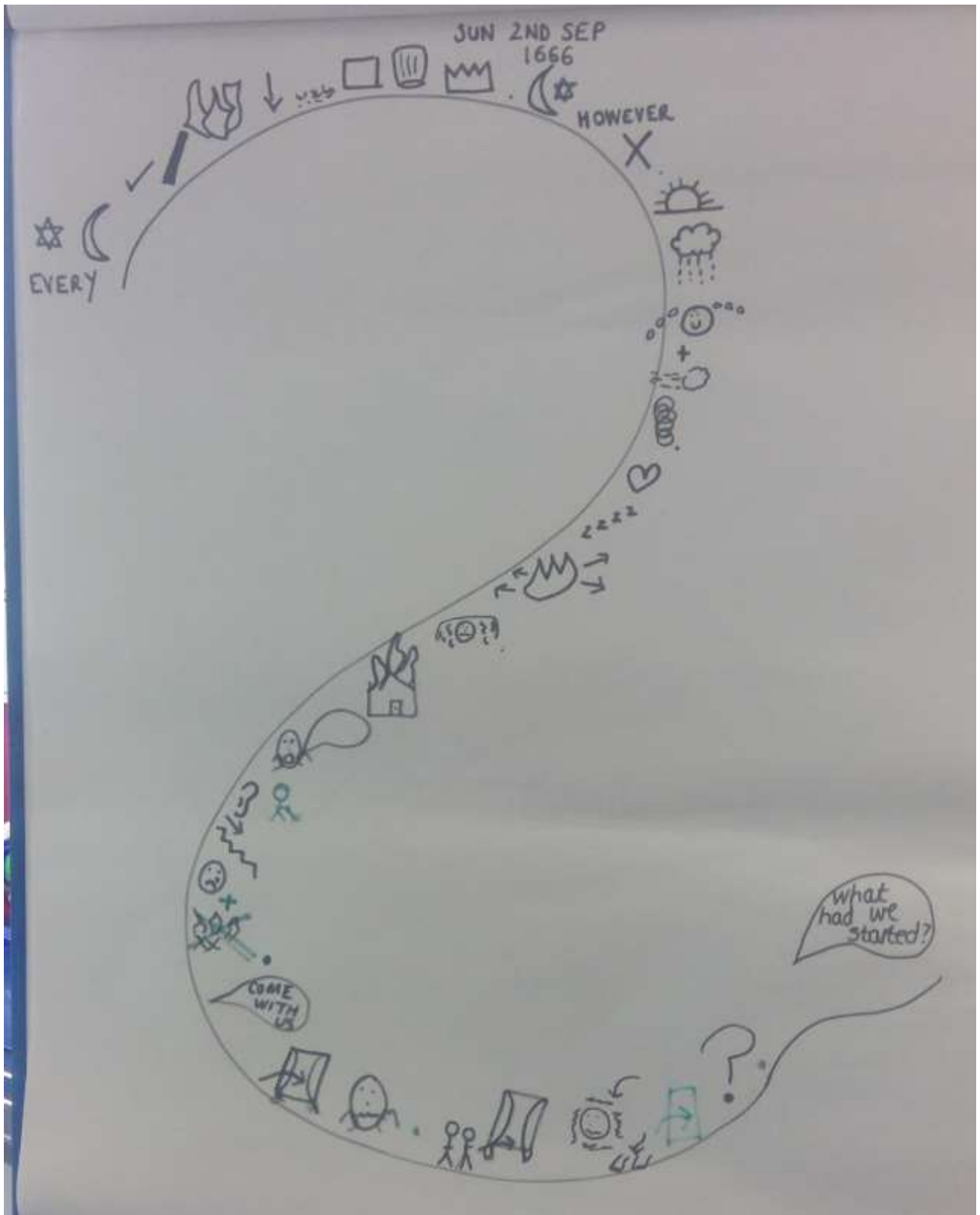
Mental maths
