The parents of each class will be responsible for organising volunteers to set up, run and take down the stall. The PTFA will organise all resources and cash floats needed for the stalls, we are just asking for your time. We will be holding a zoom meeting in mid-June to go over the running of the stalls and require at least one parent per class to attend so they know what is expected on the day and so any questions you may have can be answered. If you can't help during the fete but can help set up or clear away, we would greatly appreciate you attending this evening too. The date of this meeting will be communicated nearer the time.

Please be aware, if you have a committee member of the PTFA as a parent in your class, we are all required to set up and run other stalls, therefore cannot be used to run the class stalls.

We have negotiated with the school to arrange a film afternoon for all Seal students who help in some capacity with the set up, running or tidying away of the fete, so do encourage your children to help too!

Seal Showcase Arena

We will be holding our very own Farm Show during the Fete with a presentation from each year group on the animal they have been learning about. It will be a fantastic opportunity for the children to present to an audience and for us as parents and families to learn more about their farm education. Please encourage your child to take part and invite your friends and family along to watch.

There will also be some free fun family races, a Gymboree session (weather dependent), a knot tying lesson and lots more, so do get your children to sign up for them on the day!

Other ways you can help:

We have two stalls which require specific skills: face painting and hair braiding. If you can offer your skills to help run these stalls that would also be fantastic.
