

Need help with nursery?



A little bit about our groups

Non-bookable services

Just turn up as and when you wish, but please note if sessions get too busy it will be on first come first served basis.

Stay and Play: Families can enjoy a story and then have some fun with activities related to the story. This could be messy play, role-playing and arts and crafts (0-4 years).

Rhyme Time: Join us to sing songs and play with instruments at a local library, Swanley, Eden Centre (Edenbridge), New Ash Green and Hartley (0-4 years).

Baby Group: For babies from newborn until walking, involves sensory play, heuristic play and singing, plus a chance for parents to meet and babies to socialise with other babies.

Child Health Clinic & Breastfeeding Support: A drop in clinic for you to come along, have your baby weighed and speak to a member of the Health Visiting Team. Breast Feeding information, advice and support is also available. Call 0300 123 4497

Baby Massage: 4 Week Course: Learn some basic baby massage strokes and techniques, supports building a bond with your baby whilst being good for your baby's physical development. Can help with colic discomfort and supports babies awareness of their own body. From 8 weeks to pre-crawling.

Pathway Play: A chance for children with additional needs to explore sensory activities and toys or if they would prefer, they can access the dark den area for some peace and quiet. A time for parents to meet and support each other.

ASC Get Together: This group is for parents of children with an ASC diagnosis or on the pathway for a diagnosis. The group is delivered virtually on Thursdays 10:30am to 11:30am and 7pm to 8pm, term time only. This is a great forum to chat to other families in similar circumstances. Parents support each other and can provide useful tips and strategies.
